The Chapel Project...

We cannot wait to see the faces of the returning campers when they enter the chapel. Amazin'! We praise God for the workers from ECC (Lafayette, IN), West Bay Covenant (Traverse City, MI) and Ball State University's Christian Student Foundation and Catholic Student Union (Muncie, IN). These three groups contributed more than 2000 man hours and \$7000 toward renovating the Chapel, where God's people have invested a little more than \$18,000.

There are two more phases to the Chapel Project, renovating the basement and adding bathrooms. Both depend upon fund raising and recruiting teams for the work. Three teams have already committed to work projects this summer, and others are preparing for trips after the camp season.

The bathroom addition, which will include handicap access and 4 toilets, is estimated to cost \$25,000 in materials, permits, and septic field installation. Renovating the basement will include water-proofing external walls, paint, new floor/ ceiling, improve lighting/ electrical, and install divider walls to separate storage and meeting areas.

Weathering the Storm...

Many storms have rumbled through the Appalachians this spring. One brought us tennis ball-sized hail! The insurance adjustor noted damage to the roofs on the manager's house, the Chapel, the Recreation Center, the Staff House, and both bathhouses. The funds from the insurance settlement (~\$14,000) will be used to hire a contractor for replacement of the roofs on the manager's house and the Chapel, both of which are a little steep for volunteers. The others will be replaced as work teams are available.
