We were grateful for this team's energy and involvement with the campers!!

We also hosted mission teams from Mission Covenant Church (Foster City, MI) and Advance Community Christian Church (Advance, IN). Praise God for the new paint in the dining hall, refinished benches for the fire circle, curtains for the girls cabins, new shingles on the boys bathhouse, and the last of the sand for the volleyball field!
